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INTRODUCTION

St. Michael's College, Cherthala reflects the lofty pedagogical mission of the Diocese of Alappuzha which has been devoting long years to the formation of erudite citizens for India by imparting value-based education through the selfless service of men of commitment and dedication. The official inauguration of the college took place on 29th September 1967 with Prof. John Mathai, the Vice-chancellor of the University on the dais. The college is situated on the highway 18 kms north of Alappuzha town, silhouetted against a captivating greenery and scenery. The sprawling campus of the college with its solemn and serene air is a magnificent sight to see from the national highway – NH 66. Its magnificence suits it as the prime institute under the Diocese of Alappuzha.

It took 8 long years since its commencement to raise St. Michael's from a pre-degree to a graduate college. It was in 1976 that a new degree course in Zoology was sanctioned to the college and thus B.Sc. Zoology began in the academic year 1976-77 itself and the official inauguration was done by the Honorable Revenue Minister Mr. Baby John and the inaugural meeting was presided over by Sri. A. Sreedhara Menon, the then University Registrar. B.A. Economics was introduced in the academic year 1977-78 and B.Sc. Chemistry in 1980. The college was placed under 2(f) 12 B of the UGC act on the 10th of February 1994. The first post graduate course, M.A. Economics, was started in the academic year 1995-96. Three new courses like B.Sc Physics, B.Com and M.Sc Polymer Chemistry were sanctioned in 1998, 1999 and 2002 respectively.

As a degree college it became imperative for the college to place itself for accreditation. After much preparation and anxious waiting, the college was accredited B+ by the NAAC on 16th September 2004. After several years of waiting, two new courses were sanctioned bringing new hopes for a better reaccreditation. M.Com was started in 2013-14 and B.A. English Literature commenced in 2014-15. The UGC sponsored B.Voc degree programmes in Software Development and Tourism and Hospitality Management that were started in 2014-15. In 2020-2021 college was sanctioned BBA (Logistics), which is a new generation course in the aided sector.

Being the only institution with a 400-meter track, the ground of the college is being utilized by various agencies for sports events and the college has become a major sports hub in the district. The college was reaccredited by NAAC with 'A' Grade on 3rd March 2015. The college has also been recognized as a regular Study Centre of IGNOU offering various courses.

The college is now on the threshold of the third cycle of accreditation and earnest preparations are underway. The academic year witnessed various activities initiated by various departments both in online and offline mode amidst Covid 19 pandemic. The details of student enrolment, graduate outcome, faculty achievements, activities organised and infrastructure development are elaborated in the Annual Report.

STUDENT ENROLMENT

During this academic year 470 students enrolled in the first year. Out of which 420 students at Degree level and 50 students at Post Graduate level took admission. The gender-wise and category-wise details of students enrolled during the academic year 2020-21 are given in table 1.


International Webinar On "Opportunities in Shipping And Logistics Industry"

The volunteers conducted an awareness campaign in order to educate the people around them to take the vaccine at the earliest. As a part of the observance, the volunteers popularised vaccination through digital posters and verbal communication.

'Gaudium 2021': International Day of Happiness (20.03.2021): International Day of Happiness aims to make people around the world realize the importance of happiness in their lives. As part of observation, the NSS unit of our college conducted a programme entitled 'GAUDIUM 2021'. As part of the programme, the volunteers of the unit shared the happiest moments of their life in a frame and all the frames were prepared into a collage. In the scenario of the pandemic, these activities proclaimed the importance of happiness, to ensure mental health, among the volunteers and their families.

World TB Day (24.03.2021): WHO observes World Tuberculosis (TB) Day on March 24 to raise public awareness about the devastating health, social and economic consequences of TB, and to step up efforts to end the global TB epidemic. 'KOVIDUKALA PRATHIROTHAM' (COVID PREVENTION, 19.07.2020): A webinar was conducted on covid prevention during the pandemic period by the unit via Google Meet on 19.07.2020. The college Principal Dr. Mathew V inaugurated the ceremony and the resource person Ms. Mercy Mathew, Staff Nurse, Department of Medical Education, Government Medical College, Alappuzha delivered the keynote address and gave valuable information on the topic. (03.08.2020): NSS unit of St. Michael's College, Cherthala conducted a pre-monsoon campaign named Prevention of Monsoon Diseases to create awareness among the public regarding the causes of diseases related to monsoon and the methods to prevent the spread. The volunteers from Zoology made digital posters and videos related to monsoon diseases and circulated them through social media.

NSS DAY CELEBRATION - 'Covidum Njanum' (24.09.2020): Our NSS Unit and Alappuzha District Health Department and District Mass Media Section jointly organized a webinar on "Covid and I" in connection with the NSS Day Celebration on 24.09.2020. The webinar was presented

by Mr. R. Harilal, Health Inspector, CHC Thanneermukkam. The event was held via Google Meet on 24/9/2020 at 11.00 am. Programme officers, Volunteer secretaries, and volunteers participated in the programme.

National Cancer Awareness Day (07.11.2020): As a part of the observance, the volunteers conducted a quiz competition. The competition was conducted online and the first was won by Christy Benny of Department of Chemistry. The day is observed with the message 'Early detection is the best way for a complete cure'

World AIDS Day (01.12.2020): In connection with AIDS day the volunteers of the unit conducted an AIDS awareness on December 1, 2020. The resource person for the day was Dr. Jesina Samuel, RTI clinic, Medical College Kottayam. The awareness class was conducted in collaboration with the Red Ribbon Club of the college. Environment Day **Punarjani:** World (Rebirth, 29.05.2020-**04.06.2020):** World Environment Day is celebrated every year as a reminder to humanity about the role of the environment and the need for conserving it. This year a one-week challenge was placed before the volunteers in connection with World Environment Day 2020 from 30.05.2020 to 05.06.2020. They were encouraged to plant a tree sapling every day during this week and thereby our unit aimed to plant thousands of new saplings. As a part of this programme volunteers planted tree saplings on the premise of their houses, in the adopted village and on the campus. Saplings were distributed to students by the principal Dr. Mathew V. and the Manager Fr. Nelson Thaiparambil in the presence of Programme Officer Dr. Seena Kurian. The programme proved to be a grand success because, apart from their sapling at home, most of the volunteers extended this challenge to their friends and family members.
