## **Action Taken Report**

#### Meeting 1

Action Taken Report on Agendas Discussed in the first meeting of IQAC dated 08/06/2015.

The following actions were taken in response to the agendas discussed during the meeting held on 8th June 2015. The progress made on each agenda item is as follows:

- 1. Improvement of Academic and Institutional Activities:
  - Conducted a comprehensive review of existing academic and institutional activities to identify areas of improvement.
  - Implemented new teaching methodologies and training programs for faculty members to enhance the quality of education provided to students.
  - Monitored and evaluated the progress of ongoing initiatives to propose further improvements.
- 2. Enhancement of Academic Activities and Implementation of Academic Year Plan:

### **Meeting 2**

Action Taken Report on Meeting Held on September 30, 2015

The following actions were taken in response to the agendas discussed during the meeting held on 30th September 2015. The progress made on each agenda item is as follows:

## 1. Conducting 2 UGC-Sponsored Seminars:

- Identified relevant topics for the UGC-sponsored seminars based on the latest trends and academic interests.
- Formed organizing committees for each seminar comprising experienced faculty members and administrative staff.
- Prepared detailed proposals outlining the seminar themes, objectives, and proposed schedules for submission to the UGC.
- Submitted the seminar proposals to the UGC and successfully obtained sponsorship for both events.

## 2. Socio-Cultural Assimilation through Social Reach Activities of the College:

- Established a plan and execute social reach activities aimed at promoting socio-cultural assimilation within the college community.
- Organized a series of cultural events, workshops, and awareness campaigns focusing on diversity, inclusivity, and social harmony.

## **Meeting 3**

Action taken report following the meeting held on 11th March 2016

- 1. Enabling Students to Explore the Best Institution Library:
  - A committee comprising teachers and the librarian was formed to assess the current state of the institution's library and identify areas of improvement.
  - The committee conducted a survey among students to understand their requirements and preferences regarding library resources.
  - Based on the survey results, plans were initiated to enhance the library's collection by procuring relevant academic books, journals, and digital resources.
  - A user-friendly online catalogue system was implemented, allowing students to search for books and resources easily.
  - Library orientation sessions were organized for new students to familiarize them with the library's facilities and resources.
- 2. Implementation of ICT-Enabled Teaching:
  - Training sessions were organized for teachers to enhance their digital literacy and proficiency in utilizing ICT tools for teaching.
