Course overview

This Certificate Course of Introduction to Indian Constitution is a course by the Department of History (Single Faculty), St. Michael's College, which has gained support from the Department of Legal Affairs, Ministry of Law & Justice, Government of India, New Delhi. This course will be a 2 months certificate course (Certificate will be issued by IQAC, St. Michael's College, Cherthala) open for all in online mode. The campus mode of the same course is offered to both Graduate and Post Graduate students of the college.

The Course of Introduction to Indian Constitution provides the students with the history of constitutional developments, and the formation of Constituent Assembly, drafting of the constitution, the relationship between fundamental duties, and rights, and other concepts. This online certification also adds other concepts related to the relationship between the prime minister, and president, and the amending powers, and the ordinance power of the Parliament.

The Online Course of Introduction to Indian Constitution is actually free but for an online certificate of participation, an exam fee of Rs. 250 has to be paid.

Certification Qualifying Details

A certification of participation for the Online Course of Introduction to Indian Constitution will be given to everyone who will successfully complete the course. The performance of the participants will be assessed through class room assignments, unit tests, seminars and a term-end exam. Those who are securing less than 50% of score in overall performance will not be eligible for certificate.

Attendance: The campus programme is a 30 hrs class based course and 75% attendance is compulsory. Attendance will be taken at each session separately (Attendance rule is subjected to College rules and policies).

Course Objectives: This course introduces students to the Constitution of India. The Constitution, being supreme law of the land, must be known to every citizen of India. It begins with the Preamble, which indicates the source and objects of it. We, the people of India, are the source of the Constitution and have resolved to constitute India into a sovereign, socialist, secular, democratic and republic. The Course has been designed for everyone to make acquaint themselves with their fundamental rights and of others. No right is absolute one; it is subject to others right, as well. Directive Principles of State Policy are nothing but rights, though not enforceable by any court. These Directive Principles are basically 'Fundamental Principles' in the governance of the country. Powers and freedoms come with responsibility, State 's responsibility to implement Directive Principles and citizens must perform their duties towards others, society and nation.

- To introduce the philosophy of Constitution of India to students.
- To acquaint them with their freedoms and responsibilities.
