World Environment Day 2022: As part of the World Environment Day celebrations NCC cadets of our college planted a few saplings on the college campus.






International Yoga Day - 2^{1st} June2022:

Observance of International Day against Drug Abuse & Illicit Trafficking:



Seminar On 'Swathandrasamaravum Pradeshika Charitravum':



Anti-drug campaign rally:

The NCC and NSS Units of our college jointly organized an anti-drug campaign rally on 20th October 2022. More than 70 students participated in the programme. They started the rally in front of the college library and went along the highway till the 11th mile junction and displayed the anti-drug posters made by the NCC cadets and NSS volunteers to the public and returned to the campus. It attracted the public and captured their minds.

Enrolment of first year cadets:

The enrolment process was done on 29th October 2022. A team of Army officers from the 11(K) Battalion NCC Alappuzha came to the college and after the physical test they selected the suitable cadets from the group of first year students who were interested



to join NCC. In this year a total number of 64 cadets were selected out of it there were three 'B' Certificate holders and they were selected as third year cadets (extension).

<u>Constitution Day 2022: Know your constitution – civic awareness programme:</u>

The NCC and NSS units of our college in association Nehru Yuva Kendra Alappuzha under Ministry of Youth affairs and sports, Government of India observed the Constitution Day 2022 on 26th November 2022. They jointly organized a rally along the national highway and more than 100 students participated in the programme.

Wall Painting: Anti-drug Campaign:

The NCC and NSS units of our college launched a venture of wall painting as part of an anti-drug campaign. The students started cleaning the wall south to the college ground and its premises on 29th November 2022.

Nature Education Camp at Parambikulam Wildlife Sanctuary 2022:

Department of Botany and National Cadet Corps of St. Michael's College, Cherthala jointly organized a Nature Education Camp in collaboration with Kerala Forests and Wildlife Department at Parambikulam Wildlife Sanctuary, Anappady, Palakkad from 13.12.2022 to 15.12.2022. 35 NCC cadets participated in the camp. Dr. Teny David, Assistant Professor in Botany, Lt. Abin Albert, Assistant Professor in Economics & amp; NCC Officer and Ms. Betty Merin Eapen, Assistant Professor in English led the camp. The camp was aimed to educate students about the importance and role of nature in the existence of human beings and prepare them to act against the challenges of habitat destruction and climate change. The camp included classes, bird watching, interpretation center visit, field visits, safari and trekking.





The students visited different forest types such as evergreen, deciduous, bamboo and wayals and spotted Asiatic Elephant, Hanuman Langur, Nilgiri Langur, Malabar Giant Squirrel, Wild Boar, Sambar Deer, Spotted Deer, Peacock, Bonnet Macaque, Wild Gour, Butterflies (Blue striped Peacock, Yellow Orange tip, Indian Common Sailor, Tiger butterfly, Crimpson Rose), many medicinal & amp; common plants and Kannimara teak(One of the world's largest living teak). They experienced the presence of Tiger, Leopard and Bear through their scratch marks, droppings and pug marks. Students were given classes on tiger & amp; its conservation, butterflies & amp; butterfly gardens and different type of plants such as star plants, 'dasapushpas' and medicinal plants. Students also observed tribal settlements of Kadar, Muduvans, Malasar and Malaimalasar. The camp



was a success in terms of creating a mind of environmental consciousness among the cadets.

Annual Trining Camp at Kanichukulangara:

46 cadets of our college participated in the Annual Training Camp of NCC held at VHSS, Kanichukulangara from 24th to 31st December 2022. The SW cadets have won First prize in the Tug of War Competition.


Republic Day Celebration 2023:


