## WOMEN CELL ACTIVITIES 2022-2023



#### 1. A Webinar on Embracing Wellness-A Holistic Approach

Women Cell Unit of St Michael's College Cherthala organised a programme 'Embracing Wellness A Holistic Approach'. As part of this programme, an invited talk on "Breast Cancer Awareness" was conducted for all girl students. Prof Sr.Preetha Mary, Avinashlingam Institute for Home Science and Higher Education for Women, Coimbatore was the resource person for the day. The program was on 11/8/2022 at 3 pm at Fenicio Digital Seminar Hall. The resource person made aware the students about the need for self-examination for early detection of breast cancer with power point presentations and video clips. The students attended the class with great interest and cleared their doubts regarding the disease. This programme was conducted with the motto of Freedom from illness as part of "Azadi Ka Amruth Mahotsav". A total of 200 girl students attended the programme.





## **2.INSIGHT-Orientation program for First** semester girl students


#### 7. "Mughaamugham" programme

Talk 2 was delivered by a practicing senior advocate M. M Salichan. He discussed in detail the

He gave a framework of many laws including Sexual Harassment at work place, Domestic Violence Act and also convinced them the stringency of the law. About 100 boys participated in the programe. Students put forward their doubts and it was well cleared by the resource person.







#### 13. Hemoglobin Detection camp

Women Cell in association with Health Department, Kerala organised a blood test-hemoglobin camp to detect anemia among girl students on 27.03.2023. The programme was organized for final year girl students. The students who had anemia or low hemoglobin levels were given were given iron tablets. The students who needs further check up were referred to consult physicians. The blood test campaign was conducted in Women Cell room and students were much benefited by the camp.
