



Green Audit

As environmental sustainability is becoming an increasingly important issue for the nation, the role of higher educational institutions in relation to environmental sustainability is more prevalent. It becomes essential to adopt the system of the Green Campus for the institutes which will lead for sustainable development and at the same time reduce a sizable amount of atmospheric CO₂ from the environment. The National Assessment and Accreditation Council, New Delhi (NAAC) has made it mandatory that all the higher education institutions should prepare its annual Green Audit Report. Moreover, it is part of the social responsibility of the higher educational institutions to ensure that they contribute towards the reduction of global warming through carbon footprint reduction measures.

Scope

Green Audit is a process of systematic identification, quantification, recording, reporting and analysis of components of environmental diversity of institute. It aims to analyse environmental practices within and outside of the concerned place, which will have an impact on the eco-friendly atmosphere. Green audit is a valuable means for a college to determine how and where they are using the most energy or water or other resources; the college can then consider how to implement changes and make savings. It can create health consciousness and promote

environmental awareness, values and ethics. It provides staff and students better understanding of green impact on campus. Green Audit was initiated against the background of growing concern over changing climate and related aspects. It is a tool to identify the range of environmental impact and assess the compliance of the operations on the development and regular activities within an organisation. It is one of the important tools to check the balance of natural resources and its judicial use. Green auditing is the process of identifying and determining whether institutional practices are eco-friendly and sustainable. It is a process of regular identification, quantification, documenting, reporting and monitoring of environmentally important components in a specified area.

With this view in mind our college had conducted a green audit during this year. The Green audit conducted in the campus was supervised by Nature's Green Guardian Foundation. The Management had discussions with the officials of the audit team. A team of teachers and students were formed for conducting the data collection process. Smt. Minnu Mathew, Department of Statistics and Dr. Teny David, Department of Botany were given the charge of green audit. The audit had been done for Bio diversity, Energy, Water and Waste, Transportation, Health, Sanitation, Accessibility and Gender Justice. The list of team members is given below.

Group Reports

Report on Biodiversity Audit

Bio-diversity team started the data collection on 20.4.2023. The task was to collect data from the biodiversity of the 16-acre college campus including the hostel, kids' zone and large wild area. The Bio-diversity team was a team of 6 students along with their teacher-in charge Ms. Patricia Michael of the Department of Zoology. To make the work a little faster the college campus was divided into different blocks named A, B, C etc. The teacher in charge and a team of 3 members were assigned to work on each block. The work was started on lapwing garden which was one of the attractions of the campus. It was a surprise that the team discovered so much biodiversity even in the college ground. They also sought the help of other teachers of the Department, non-teaching staff and also used technologies to find out the names of plants and

animals. They also visited a nearby nursery - South Indian Argo Farm who helped to identify the garden plants. The first challenge faced was the intense heat during the month; however, identification became easier as many plants bloom in these months. Auditing was more challenging in the cashew plantation due to the plant density. Necessary precautions were taken and then the auditing was completed in that block. The team also took photographs of fauna and rare plants. Nearly 248 plant species and 122 animal species were identified and a count of around 440 trees; its girth data was taken. Data consisted around; 60 herbs sp, 60 shrub sp, 14 climber sp, 3 creeper sp, 1 twinner and 93 trees sp. Faunal species include, 1 species of annelid, of the 81 species of Arthropoda, 77 species of insects, 1 scorpion sp and two sp of milliped was identified., 2 species of snails, 1sp of fish, 6 species of lizard, 5 species of snakes, 1 species of squirrel, 28



species of aves. Photographs of unidentified species were also sent for identification.

Hostel areas had the highest varieties of plants and trees and also a large number of cashew plantations. Butterflies are frequent visitors of the front garden. Cashew and acacia are the trees mainly found in the campus. The collected data were tabulated, scrutinized rechecked and submitted it in the first week of June.

Although we cannot claim to have identified every biological species in our campus as even the smallest creatures might have escaped from the sight, the smallest blade of grass may have gone unnoticed it is sure that the team had put all their effort and hard work into this project of green auditing the biodiversity of St Michael's college.

Report on Energy Audit

The energy audit data collection of St. Michaels college Cherthala was conducted during the last week of April 2023. It was conducted with the help of 6 students and their teacher in charge Dr. Saneesh Sebastian.

The entire college was divided into MIMAT building, Main building, Library block, Canteen and Hostel. The auditing was started with MIMAT building and collected the data on the first day. The data with regard to different electrical equipment's including fan, tube light (both normal tube and LED tube), number of plug points including normal plug and power plug, LCD projector if any, Computer etc were collected.

The team visited the main building and all the class rooms in it on the second day. In all the class rooms there were fans, LED tube lights and one or two plug points. In final year class rooms, there are LCD projectors in addition. In different Departments in addition to fan and light there were computers and a small printer. The total number and also the average working time of each equipment was noted and the average power consumption was calculated.

On the third day the students were divided into two groups and the girl students were sent to the ladies hostel and the other group to KIDZONE building. The details regarding the electric equipment outside the building (mainly electric motors) were collected. Both groups completed the data collection before lunch. In the afternoon session the team visited the chapel, conference hall and seminar hall. All the electric equipment including air conditioner and different fancy lights were listed out.

On the fourth day (last day) morning, the team visited the library building to list out all the equipment there. The data collected during the four days were then consolidated. Along with the electrical data, the LPG and Solar energy data of the college was also compiled. The Energy Audit programme of the college was concluded in the first week of May 2023.

Report on Water & Waste Audit

Water and waste audit is one of the main sections of Green Audit of St. Michael's college. The teacher in charge of this internal audit team was Dr. Smisha M A, Assistant Professor, Department of Mathematics along with 6 students.

After the formation of team, a detailed questionnaire was prepared based on the recommendations of the external agency who is preparing the Green Audit Report. The team collected information that was addressed in the questionnaire.

The college has a pond of 335000 L capacity and 7 borewells. The ponds and other water resources in the college are well maintained.

Separate tanks were installed for different blocks and for different purposes. This enables to use water with maximum potential control.

The college has rain water harvesting mechanism which is to be appreciated. This will help generate awareness about the importance of water conservation and shall act as a model system to be followed by other institutions as well.

The college organizes awareness programmes on water conservation frequently to spread the message of significance of conserving water.

161148 L of water is used per day by the college for its different uses including 90000 L for gardening.

The water consumption in the summer season is significantly high compared to other months.

The college has a RO plant of 5000L capacity and RO wastage (30% of input water) uses for agriculture purpose.

Report on Transportation Audit

Transportation audit team was led by Lt. Abin Albert T as the teacher in charge and 5 students. For the collection of data regarding transportation, a Google form containing the relevant questions were prepared and circulated among students and staff of St. Michael's College Cherthala. 648 responses were received and it was compiled and sent to the concerned authority.

Report on Health and Sanitation, Accessibility, Gender Justice

This Group was assigned the following topics: Health, Sanitation, accessibility, and Gender Justice. The Group started its data collection on April 20 after having prepared the essential data forms and other necessary items. The group consisted of seven students along with their in-charge teacher, Dr. Seena Kurian.

The group first collected data on accessibility and gender justice. The group collected various information on the number of gates, the wheel chair-accessible ones, and also information about the buildings and their accessibility to wheel



chairs and other differently abled people. The campus has an accessible bathroom on the ground floor and ramp facility for easy access to all floors. The students then collected information on the number of medical leaves taken by the students during the period for the health audit. They also collected certificates and photographs of the events in which students participated. The water audit was taken in the chemistry lab of the college on May 19, 2023, and it was found that the water used had a normal pH. Finally, the cleaning schedules were observed and recorded. It took about two months to complete the audit.

Future Plans:

- St. Michael's College, Cherthala, envisions a future plan that aims to transform itself into a centre of excellence in education and research.

With a well-rounded approach to education and a focus on research, sustainability, and community development, St. Michael's College, Cherthala, is committed to shaping the


